

2020 Community Guidelines

2020 Community is an online forum for 2020 users to ask and answer questions on a wide range of topics relating to 2020 solutions. These guidelines are here to help you do your part in making the community a collaborative and enriching place.

Users should not make posts that:

- A) Contain hate or discrimination. The 2020 forums are for civil, constructive discussion. Hateful posts will be removed and the users who posted them may be probated. For example: racial slurs, sexist comments or discriminatory comments.
- B) Contain sexually explicit references. For example: describing sexual scenes or acts in explicit detail.
- C) Antagonise others in an obnoxious manner. For example: comments that provoke hostile responses.
- D) Personally attack or defame other users. For example: direct insults towards others, causing harm to the reputation of others.
- E) Contain references to illegal activity. For example: explicit drug references, discussion or the planning of real world criminal activity, discussion or the planning of prohibited activity such as the purchase of prohibited software.
- F) Disrupt forum use for others. For example: bumping threads too frequently, posting the same or similar content in multiple threads, derailing threads with off topic comments.
- G) Are negative or disparaging toward 2020 or 2020 software. For example: negative comments about a feature in 2020's software product compared to a similar feature in a competitor's tool.
- H) Exploit the community. 2020 forums is a place to share knowledge and ask questions relating to 2020 solutions. It is not a forum to advertise, recruit or solicit business.
- I) Contain spam, advertising or self-promotion. Spam is defined as unsolicited advertisements for goods, services and/or other websites, or posts with unrelated content. Do not spam the 2020 forums with links to your site or products or try to self-promote a website, a business or another forum.
- J) Ask for email addresses or phone numbers. In this case, your account will be banned permanently and your posts deleted.

If a post is deemed to infringe these guidelines, the post may be edited or removed and the user's access may be restricted.
