

2020 Customer Spotlight



The panel of judges highlighted the contrasting flooring materials and bold panel fabrics as details in the design that would show the client exactly how their space will look and feel.

In this way, her parents have been her biggest influence in her career choice. but finds her best method of learning is trial and error. Kara considers the paint palette feature to be one of the most beneficial features in the software. "Being able to apply grades of finishes, grommets, pull handles and laminate directions saves everyone a lot of time in the end."

Advice to Designers

Kara advises other designers to ask clients as many questions as possible! "How many users, what size work surfaces, storage, privacy, collaboration spaces are required? Get all the technical questions answered so you can get down to the fun part of designing their 'look'."

When asked about inspiration, Kara responded that her inspiration comes from all over. "History is one of my biggest influences. I also pull inspiration from nature, magazine covers, my boss' socks...you never know when inspiration is going to hit, so I'm always observing."
